

CONFLICTS

- Must Communicate Two Weeks in Advance When Possible
 - Sports Conflicts Need to Know ASAP!
 - Please Give Us a Copy of Your Meet/Tournament Schedule and Highlight Conflicting Dates.
- We Will Never Require an Event Without Two Weeks or More Notice
- Communicating a Conflict Does NOT Automatically Mean Grade is Excused
 - Excused Absences:
 - School Activities (We Work with Sports Conflicts, but Ask that Students Make Every Effort to Attend Both Events)
 - Illness or Family Emergency
 - Unexcused Absences (Resulting in a Zero)
 - Work/Job
 - Lack of Transportation
 - Birthday Parties
 - Club Sports or Other Non KSHSAA/School Sponsored Activities

BAND FEES

- Uniform Cleaning Fee for Marching Band: \$25 (DISTRICT FEE) Subject to Change Due to New Uniforms Coming In
- Instrument Rental Fee for District Owned Instruments: \$25 Charged Per Month (DISTRICT FEE) Includes Percussion and Switching Instruments for Concert Season
- Marching Band Show Shirt: Approximately \$25
- Marching Band Shoes (Drillmasters): New: \$40, Used: \$20 • Sizes Will Vary on Used Shoes; First Come, First Serve
- Marching Gloves: \$3/Pair
 - Students are Required to Have 2 Pairs of Gloves

THINGS TO KNOW

- Marching Band Competition Days are Long
 - We Often Leave Very Early and Come Home Late (Past Midnight)
- All Uniform Parts are the Student's Responsibility Missing Items Become a Financial Obligation
- Alternates are Still Expected to Attend All Events
- COMMUNICATION is Key!
 - We Want Students to be Involved in Lots of Activities, But Please Remember that Band is Co-Curricular.



SERVICE DUTIES

• What Is It?

- Encourages All Students to Take Ownership in the Band Program. May Include Things Such As, But Not Limited To:
 - Filing Music in the Library
 - Making Copies
 - Helping with Instrument Display Nights at VCIS, or Taking Attendance at VCMS/VCIS Concerts Loading/Unloading Van & Trailer/Buses

 - Setting Up/Tearing Down for Concerts
 - Volunteering for Events such as Mass Band (Above and Beyond)
- One Per Quarter (Four Total)
- Part of the Grade 50 Points Each



TRIPS

- Typically, We Try to Have a Big Trip Once Every Four Years, and a Smaller Regional Trip Every Two Years
- This Means Your Students Now Have The Option to Participate in a Trip Year This Next School Year
